According to the company, projects on the megawatt scale are now feasible from a commercial perspective at the lowest levelized cost of storage (LCOS). The new energy storage systems also meet operational standards over their lifetimes, specifically when co-located with renewable power generation.

For example, the estimated amount of energy storage need varies widely. Some analysis suggests that a few terawatt-hours (TWh) of storage capacity is needed, but seasonal variation requires long-duration storage of up to more than a month.

Notably, Alberta's storage energy capacity increases by 474 GWh (+157%) and accounts for the vast majority of the WECC's 491 GWh increase in storage energy capacity (from 1.94 to 2.43 TWh).

Example: An 80 watts fan used for 4 hours daily. The daily watt hour and kilowatt hour consumption is as follows. Daily power usage in Wh = $80\text{W} \times 4 \text{ Hours} = 320 \text{ Wh} / \text{day}$; Daily power usage in kWh = $320 \text{ Wh} / 1000 = 0.32 \text{ kWh} / \text{day}$

The cost of the battery needs to be reduced to less than \$100 kWh⁻¹ and the cost of the whole battery system (including the battery management system, BMS) reduced to less than \$150 kWh⁻¹. The total battery system cost will be \$15,000 for a 100 kWh vehicle.

We can calculate how much impact this will have on our monthly electricity bill. For that, we need to know the price of electricity. Let's presume that we run a 1,000 W air conditioner continuously for 1 month, with the average price of electricity being \$0.1319 per kWh. In the monthly bill, we will have to pay for 360 kWh of electricity.
