In general, large-scale underground systems of more than 4,000-5,000 cubic meters are a cost-effective option, while tanks are the smarter alternative for smaller capacity systems.

Energy. Energy can be defined as the capacity to supply heat or do work. One type of work ( $w$ ) is the process of causing matter to move against an opposing force. Thermal energy storage using ice makes use of the large heat of fusion of water. Historically, ice was transported from mountains to cities for use as a coolant. One metric ton of water (= one cubic meter) can store 334 million joules (MJ) or 317,000 BTUs (93 kWh).
