

# How to calculate the energy storage power

As you might remember from our article on Ohm's law, the power  $P$  of an electrical device is equal to voltage  $V$  multiplied by current  $I$ : As energy  $E$  is power  $P$  multiplied by time  $T$ , all we have to do to find the energy stored in a battery is to multiply both sides of the equation by time:

Determine power (MW): Calculate maximum size of energy storage subject to the interconnection capacity constraints. Determine energy (MWh): Perform a dispatch analysis based on the signal or frequency data to determine the duration needed (typically 15 minutes to 1 ...

Then we can calculate the heat generated by the lighting, this is fairly simple to do and we can use the formula.  $Q = \text{lamps} \times \text{time} \times \text{wattage} / 1000$  .  $Q = \text{kWh/day}$ , lamps = number of lamps within the cold room; time = hours of use per day; wattage = power rating of the lamps; 1000 = converts the Watts to kW.

The unit of the energy density of storage is  $\text{Wh/l}$ , and its power density is  $\text{W/kg}$ , where  $L$  is its length in  $\text{m}$ .
