

# How to convert energy storage into electricity

**Thermal Energy Storage:** Thermal energy storage is a method of storing electricity by converting it into heat or cold. This storage method is commonly used in concentrated solar power (CSP) systems, where the heat generated by solar thermal collectors is stored in molten salt or other materials.

When electrical energy is delivered to both the electrodes, moving free electrons are injected into the cathode. Rich in electrons, the cathode attracts the positive ions  $\text{Na}^+$  within the electrolytic solution. The chemical reaction between  $\text{Na}^+$  ions and free electrons  $e^-$  creates a new chemical compound Na, deposited into the cathode electrode..  $\text{Na}^+ + e^- \rightarrow \text{Na}$

The system would absorb excess energy from renewable sources such as the sun and store that energy in heavily insulated banks of hot graphite. When the energy is needed, such as on overcast days, TPV cells would convert the heat into electricity, and dispatch the energy to a power grid.

An electric generator is a device that converts a form of energy into electricity. There are many different types of electricity generators. 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An illustrative example from methane to chemical conversion (without electricity production), 1 mol n-butanol requires 4 mol CH<sub>4</sub> as the carbon source, yet it only contains 76% of the original energy despite 100% carbon yield [7], hence finding ways to capture part of this lost energy in electricity (or other value chemicals) could be important.

Using the above numbers from 2021, and considering the entire fleet of energy sources, more energy was lost in conversion than was turned into electricity. The largest component of today's electricity system is energy loss. Energy transmission and storage cause smaller losses of energy

Fuel cells directly convert the chemical energy of hydrogen into electricity, achieving significantly higher efficiencies of 60-80 % compared to the combustion in gas turbines [109]. The reason is that gas turbines convert the energy stored in hydrogen into mechanical energy and then into electricity.

Batteries and similar devices accept, store, and release electricity on demand. Batteries use chemistry, in the form of chemical potential, to store energy, just like many other everyday energy sources. For example, logs and oxygen both store energy in their chemical bonds until burning converts some of that chemical energy to heat.
