

How to make a mobile power storage rack

You'll also probably want it accessible to a power outlet. Once you decide where to hang it, pre-drill holes in the back and attach it to the wall/studs with 3? screws (2 minimum places). Add a surge protector/power strip if desired and stock it full of your tools!

With the pocket holes drilled, I ran a bead of glue down the joint just for added stability. The 1" pocket hole screws are more than enough to hold everything together, but the glue adds a little stability and will keep the cart from squeaking while you use it.

Step 4: Install The Brackets. Use a 4-ft. level to draw a line on the wall at your chosen height. If you choose to add the weight storage onto the back of your rack, you can throw in weight storage horns to, you know, make that space usable. Uprights These are the vertical posts on a power rack. The word "up" gives it away. Crossmembers These are horizontal beams you attach to your rack that add stability and versatility.
