As energy  $E$  is power  $P$  multiplied by time  $T$ , all we have to do to find the energy stored in a battery is to multiply both sides of the equation by time:  $E = V \cdot I \cdot T$ . A 1700 mAh battery would be discharged in 3 hours by  $1700/3 \approx 570$  mA and in 4 hours by  $1700/4 \approx 425$  mA.
