Working principle of a hydraulic motor. A hydraulic motor converts hydraulic energy from oil (or any hydraulic fluid) into mechanical energy (in the form of rotary motion) to perform useful work. The basic hydraulic motor design typically comprises a reservoir (where the hydraulic fluid is stored), a pump, valves, pistons, and a rotating component.
