Hydrogen energy storage is another form of chemical energy storage in which electrical power is converted into hydrogen. This energy can then be released again by using the gas as fuel in a combustion engine or a fuel cell.

At atmospheric pressure, 1kg of hydrogen gas would require 12,000 litres of storage -- roughly the size of a large van. So to store or transport the H₂, it is usually compressed to reduce its storage volume. For example, hydrogen gas at a pressure of 700 bar requires only 26 litres of storage.

The main obstacle to the uptake of hydrogen as an energy source is the difficulty of storing it. In the still rare hydrogen-powered cars, it is stored compressed at a pressure of around 700 atmospheres. This is neither the cheapest nor the safest method, and it has little to do with efficiency: there is only 45 kg of hydrogen in one cubic meter.
