A hydrogen-air mixture explosion occurred within seconds of the release, followed by a high-pressure gas jet fire. The fire and explosion caused pipe damage and activation of hydrogen cylinder temperature-pressure relief devices, adding additional hydrogen fuel to the incident, and eventually spreading to other materials on adjacent vehicles.

Hydrogen tanks are required to use a pressure relief device (such as TPRD) to prevent explosion accidents during fire exposure. Fire test is an essential prototype test in the standard to ensure the safety performance of the high-pressure hydrogen storage tank subjected to a fire accident.

In the event of a hydrogen leak, the gas simply dissipates harmlessly. Moreover, the tanks that contain H2 are thick walled and carefully designed to prevent leaking, even after a substantial crash. The tanks in the Mirai, for example, are carbon fiber wrapped and can withstand a .50 caliber bullet without suffering a leak.

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
