This requires the use of solar energy as the thermal energy source, and a solid-liquid phase change material as an inter-seasonal energy storage medium. Generally speaking, seasonal thermal energy storage can be used by storing summer heat for winter use or storing winter cold for summer use, i.e., summer heat for winter use and winter cold for summer use. Common seasonal heat storage includes seasonal sensible heat storage, seasonal latent heat storage, and seasonal thermochemical heat storage.

The solar energy recovery is not optimal in summer because the energy level in the inter-seasonal storage is at its maximum level from July to October. During this period, the solar collector main operation is used for daily DHW needs and to cover thermal losses of the inter-seasonal storage.
