Negative electrode: "The reducing or fuel electrode--which gives up electrons to the external circuit and is oxidized during the electrochemical reaction." 2. Positive electrode: "The oxidizing electrode--which accepts electrons from the external circuit and is reduced during the electrochemical reaction."

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
