Among the many available options, electrochemical energy storage systems with high power and energy densities have offered tremendous opportunities for clean, flexible, efficient, and reliable energy storage deployment on a large scale. They thus are attracting unprecedented interest from governments, utilities, and transmission operators.

The energy storage of each module can range from relatively small capacities, such as typical capacitors that act as an intermediary device for energy conversion, or high energy/power density components, such as double-layer (super) capacitors (SCs) and batteries, which offer a significant amount of energy [74, 77,78,79].

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
