Currently, most lithium is extracted from hard rock mines or underground brine reservoirs, and much of the energy used to extract and process it comes from CO₂-emitting fossil fuels. Particularly in hard rock mining, for every tonne of mined lithium, 15 tonnes of CO₂ are emitted into the air. Battery materials come with other costs, too.

This has led to a spike in lithium mining: from 2017 to 2022, demand for lithium tripled, mostly driven by the energy sector. 1. Why is lithium so desirable for these applications? Lithium supply would need to grow sevenfold by 2030--which translates to opening 50 new lithium mines --to maintain global warming below 1.5°C. To limit global warming to 2°C, lithium output would need to grow 40-fold by 2040.

The energy sector is currently undergoing a transition towards increased utilization of green energy technologies. The green energy transition relies heavily on metals, such as aluminium, chromium, cobalt, copper, lithium, manganese, nickel, rare earth elements (REEs), silicon, tin, titanium, tungsten and zinc, among others.

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
