

Japan pumped storage power station project

The Kannagawa Hydropower Plant () is an under construction pumped-storage hydroelectric power plant near Minamiaiki in Nagano Prefecture and Ueno in Gunma Prefecture, Japan. The power plant utilizes the Minamiaiki River along with an upper and lower reservoir created by two dams, the upper Minamiaiki Dam and the lower Ueno Dam. The power station in ...

Pumped storage type power plants have been developed in Japan since 1930. Tokyo Electric Power Co., Inc. (TEPCO) has 9 pumped storage power plants with approximately 10,000 MW in total, including one under construction.

Hydroelectricity is the second most important renewable energy source after solar energy in Japan with an installed capacity of 50.0 gigawatt (GW) as of 2019. [1] According to the International Hydropower Association Japan was the world's sixth largest producer of hydroelectricity in 2020. Most of Japanese hydroelectric power plants are pumped-storage plants.

The fixed-speed pumped-storage power station has a step-type output. Take one of pumped storage power stations as an example. It takes only about 16 s from ≈ 50 MW to ≈ 300 MW, and just 14 s from ≈ 300 MW to 0 MW. It means a 300 MW unit trips several times in one day, which has a great impact on the Fujian province power grid.

Owned and operated by the Kansai Electric Power Company (KEPCO), Okuyoshino hydropower plant is located in the Shingu River system in the Nara Prefecture, in southeast Japan, as shown in figure 1. The Okuyoshino pumped storage power station benefits from a hydraulic head of 505 m, which is the difference in height between the two reservoirs.

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TEPCO now has eight pumped storage power stations. It is also planning a ninth 2700MW plant at Kannagawa but the development of the project has been delayed by a slow growth in power demand in Japan. The rapid growth of distributed gas-fired co-generation in the country's recently liberalised market may also limit the demand for pumped storage.

To address this variable demand, numerous pumped-storage plants have been built in Japan's river systems. With the best terrestrial sites now already developed, the Ministry of Economy, ...

The project is being developed and currently owned by Tokyo Electric Power Co Holdings. Kannagawa is a pumped storage project. The hydro reservoir capacity is planned to be 19.17 million cubic meter. The gross head of the project will be 653m. The penstock length will be 6,115.51m. The project is expected to generate 14,800 GWh of electricity.

The Kazunogawa Power Plant is a 1600MW underground pumped storage plant constructed by the Tokyo Electric & Power Company (TEPCO) in Japan's Yamnashi Prefecture. The project was ordered to meet peak demand, which was reaching record levels when the project was first planned in 1995.

Pumped storage hydro power stations require very specific sites, with substantial bodies of water between different elevations. There are hundreds, if not thousands, of potential sites around the UK, including disused mines, quarries and underground caverns, but the cost of developing entirely new facilities is huge.

The UK Government's confirmation of a cap and floor regime as the investment framework for new large-scale, long-duration electricity storage projects has been welcomed by renewable energy leader Drax. Despite their critical role in decarbonisation, a gap in energy policy support has hindered the development of new pumped storage hydro plants for a generation. ...

In March 1999 construction of the world's first seawater pumped storage power plant was completed in Japan. Called the Okinawa Yambaru station, the plant has a maximum output of 30MW, maximum operating head of 152m and maximum discharge of 26m³/sec. Prior to construction a six-year study of the plant was started in 1981.

The pumped- storage power station can achieve long-term storage of large-capacity power by itself. The multiple-energy- combined pumped-storage station can also improve the quantity of new energy connecting to the power grid on the premise of guaranteeing the stability and safety of the Global Energy Interconnection 240 power grid.

A risky investment uses a higher discount rate. Almost all the costs of a pumped hydro system are up front, similar to a solar or wind power station, but unlike a gas power station where most of the costs are for fuel. A typical real (after subtracting inflation) discount rate for a low-risk investment is 5%.

The Bath County Pumped Storage Station has a maximum generation capacity of more than 3 gigawatts (GW) and total storage capacity of 24 gigawatt-hours (GWh), the equivalent to the total, yearly electricity use of about 6000 homes..
