

# Japan subsidizes home energy storage systems

By Aya Takada, Bloomberg. After recent typhoons ravaged Japan's grid and disrupted power to almost 1.4 million customers, the government is encouraging homeowners to invest in storage systems, seeking to marry batteries with existing rooftop solar capacity to create backup electricity networks.

For a typical home energy storage system, the ITC can reduce the cost of your system by \$3,000 to \$5,000. Indeed, the government's three-year Basic Energy Plan aims for renewables to reach 22-24% of the national energy mix by that year. That would peg solar's share at around 64GW. Several megawatt-hours of residential battery storage systems, typically paired with solar PV, are being installed in Japan on a monthly basis. This is largely due to concerns about losing power at home, given the seismic activity the country is frequently subject to, as well as extreme weather events like typhoons.
