The Manatee Energy Storage Center is a massive battery. It is made up of 132 energy storage containers spread across a 40-acre parcel of land. It is about the size of 30 football fields! A fleet of over 340,000 solar panels spread across 751-acre property powers the system.

Utility-scale energy storage is critical to the wider adoption of solar and wind power; it enables these intermittent sources to be used when sunlight or wind are lacking and reduces the need for back-up fossil fuel-fired plants.

2.1 Potential Economic and Environmental Benefits. There are economic and environmental incentives for the introduction of large-scale electricity storage systems. Figure 1 gives a typical electricity demand (generation) profile for a sunny summer day in Japan. Base, intermediate, and peak loads are identified.

The basic driver for geological storage is that the cost per stored volume is 3-5 times less than the surface storage area. Very large volumes of energy storage are relatively inexpensive, can be used to meet seasonal demands, provide continuity in supply chain deterioration, and control in the pipeline congestion (Lord et al. 2014).

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
