Base station power supply for 5G base stations. 4.1 Problems The 5G base station AAU adopts Massive MIMO (large-scale multiple-input multiple-output) technology, which increases the power of the equipment. The power of the 5G base station is about 3 to 4 times that of the 4G base station; Supporting electricity has brought greater difficulties.
