Despite high renewable energy potential, electrical energy cost is one of the highest in the world relying mostly on fossil fuels. Liberia has more than 2.3 GW of hydro potential identified and a widespread solar irradiation and biomass vegetation. Many locations across the country offer the potential for lower cost renewable electricity.

The state of Liberia in Africa faces profound energy challenges including limited electricity access and heavy dependence on traditional biomass and imported fossil fuels with high emissions.

Liberia Energy Sector Overview . The Government of Liberia is working closely with development partners, including Power Africa, and is undertaking ambitious steps to rebuild its electricity infrastructure. The civil war, which ended in 2003, destroyed nearly all of the country's ability to provide electricity for its over four million people.

Formal electricity services are solely provided by the state-owned Liberia Electricity Corporation, which operates a small grid almost exclusively in the Greater Monrovia District. The vast majority of electric energy services is provided by small privately owned generators. At \$0.54 per kWh, the electricity tariff in Liberia is among the highest in the world.
