Explosion is the most extreme case of thermal runaway [7] will lead to devastating consequences because the energy is released in a very short time with multiple forms, such as high temperature and shock wave [8]. In recent years, fire and explosion accidents in energy storage power stations have been common, according to statistics, there have been more than 30 fires in energy storage power stations in the world in the past year. Since August 2017, there have been 29 fire accidents in energy storage power stations in South Korea.
