

The RES Top Gun Energy Storage project is a 30-MW)/120 MWh lithium-ion battery energy storage system located in San Diego, California. The project was developed by RES Group and is owned and operated by San Diego Gas & Electric (SDG& E). The project was completed in September 2021 and cost US\$60m to build.

The \$100 million-plus project will feature 156 tractor trailer-like containers spread across five acres in the Gorham Industrial Park, stuffed with lithium iron phosphate batteries. It's being built by Houston-based Plus Power LLC, which has 60 energy storage projects online or in development across the United States and Canada.

Calpine and GE Renewable Energy completed the Santa Ana Storage Project in southern California. The project contains a 20MW/80MWh (4 hour) standalone battery energy storage system using GE's Reservoir energy storage technology. The system is supported by a 20-year Resource Adequacy Power Purchase Agreement (PPA).

Sodium-ion is one technology to watch. To be sure, sodium-ion batteries are still behind lithium-ion batteries in some important respects. Sodium-ion batteries have lower cycle life (2,000-4,000 versus 4,000-8,000 for lithium) and lower energy density (120-160 watt-hours per kilogram versus 170-190 watt-hours per kilogram for LFP).

Prices: Both lithium-ion battery pack and energy storage system prices are expected to fall again in 2024. Rapid growth of battery manufacturing has outpaced demand, which is leading to significant downward pricing pressure as battery makers try to recoup investment and reduce losses tied to underutilization of their plants.

Lithium secondary batteries store 150-250 watt-hours per kilogram (kg) and can store 1.5-2 times more energy than Na-S batteries, two to three times more than redox flow batteries, and about five times more than lead storage batteries. Charge and discharge efficiency is a performance scale that can be used to assess battery efficiency.
