Without energy storage, electricity must be produced and consumed at exactly the same time.

Supercapacitors, which can charge/discharge at a much faster rate and at a greater frequency than lithium-ion batteries are now used to augment current battery storage for quick energy inputs and output. Graphene battery technology--or graphene-based supercapacitors--may be an alternative to lithium batteries in some applications.

However, the battery can still be useful for other energy storage purposes, such as, for example, the inclusion of storage systems in the charging infrastructure for electric vehicles, which help to sustain the grid.
