This formula accounts for the energy stored within the PCM during its phase change.

Energy stored as sensible heat in materials. Thermal energy can be stored as sensible heat in a material by raising its temperature. The heat or energy storage can be calculated as Heat is stored in 2 m<sup>3</sup> granite by heating it from 20 °C to 40 °C. The density of granite is 2400 kg/m<sup>3</sup> and the specific heat of granite is 790 J/kg°C.

Gravimetric energy density, sometimes referred to as specific energy, is the available energy per unit mass of a substance. Gravimetric energy density is typically expressed in Watt-hours per kilogram (Wh/kg), or Megajoules per kilogram (MJ/kg). The gravimetric energy density gives the energy content of a fuel in terms of storage and handling of the substance.
