The system utilizes 200 carbon fiber flywheels levitated in a vacuum chamber. The flywheels absorb grid energy and can steadily discharge 1-megawatt of electricity for 15 minutes.

While many papers compare different ESS technologies, only a few research, studies design and control flywheel-based hybrid energy storage systems. Recently, Zhang et al. present a hybrid energy storage system based on compressed air energy storage and FESS.

Pictured above, it has a total installed capacity of 30MW with 120 high-speed magnetic levitation flywheel units. Every 12 units create an energy storage and frequency regulation unit, the firm said, with the 12 combining to form an array connected to the grid at a 110 kV voltage level.

FESS, with their excellent characteristics, can be viable alternatives to other storage systems for this application. Particularly, a fast response, high power density, and frequent charge-discharge cycle capability, are the best attributes of flywheels for voltage compensation applications.
