Microgrids (MGs) are playing a fundamental role in the transition of energy systems towards a low carbon future due to the advantages of a highly efficient network architecture for flexible integration of various DC/AC loads, distributed renewable energy sources, and energy storage systems, as well as a more resilient and economical on/off-grid control, ...
