This may be a valuable opportunity in the future, and the costs and benefits should be considered as the markets mature. Dependence on large quantities of diesel fuel represents an important vulnerability for military installations. Many installations do not have the volume of diesel stored on base to meet a 14-day outage.

This development has allowed Chinese defense installations to establish an energy support system predominantly relying on electricity, supplemented by fuel, solar energy, and wind energy. The integration into the national power grid is expected to significantly elevate the Chinese military's border management and control capabilities.

The increasing diversity of energy generation technologies brings a wider range of energy storage technologies on the research agenda.
