Around 96% of the world's energy storage capacity is pumped hydro energy storage. In 2020, there were more than 8,000 gigawatts (GW) of pumped hydro storage capacity globally. That is set to grow to almost 12,000 GWs by 2026.

It is an elderly system; however, it is still widely used nowadays, because it presents a mature technology and allows a high degree of autonomy and does not require consumables, nor cutting-edge technology, in the hands of a few countries.

It includes a number of generation and storage technologies, predominantly hydroelectricity and Pumped Hydro Energy Storage (PHES). Hydropower is one of the oldest and most mature energy technologies, and has been used in various forms for thousands of years.

The pumped hydro storage part, shown in Fig. 6.2, initiates when the demand falls short, and the part of the generated electricity is used to pump water from the lower reservoir back into the upper reservoir. Since this operation is allowed to take place for a time duration from six to eight hours (before the demand surges up again the next day), the power used up by the ...
