Energy storage for medium- to large-scale applications is an important aspect of balancing demand and supply cycles. Nevertheless, energy storage becomes necessary if these challenges are to be fully addressed. Among the most commonly deployed technologies to support energy storage is Pumped Storage Hydropower, say experts. It centres on the use of surplus power during peak generation to pump water into a reservoir located at a certain height.

The Importance and Innovations of Pumped Storage Hydropower. Pumped storage hydropower--or PSH--is like a big energy bank that can switch on to help power our grid alongside other renewables, like wind and solar.

One study found that about 60% of MSW generated in Muscat is composed of bio-waste, namely food waste, papers, textiles, and wood . It has also been estimated that the annual food waste composition of a typical landfill in Oman is about 140,000 tons .

Pumped storage hydropower represents the bulk of the United States' current energy storage capacity: 23 gigawatts (GW) of the 24-GW national total (Denholm et al. 2021). Pumped hydro energy storage could be used as daily and seasonal storage to handle power system fluctuations of both renewable and non-renewable energy (Prasad et al., 2013). This is because PHES is fully dispatchable and flexible to seasonal variations, as reported in New Zealand (Kear and Chapman, 2013), for example.
