Morocco"s strategic initiative to replace coal power plants with natural gas combined-cycle power plants emerges as a potential solution to enhance power system resilience against water stress. The national plan aims to install an additional 2,400 MW of natural gas power plant capacity by 2030 and completely phase out coal-fired plants by 2050.

WIND POWER: Initiated in June 2010, the integrated wind project is expected to add 2000 MW of capacity by 2020, the equivalent of 6600 GWh per year, for a total investment of Dh31.5bn (EUR2.9bn). In 2011 Morocco had a total installed wind power capacity of 289 MW, while an additional 720 MW was under development and a further 1000 MW was being planned.

The Noor solar energy plant was the country's first renewable energy project. Four more solar plants were expected to follow, providing a total of 2 GW of power by 2020 to cover the country's energy demands, which were met by imports to the tune of up to 95%. The first large-scale electricity storage project in Morocco is the 460 MW Afourer Pumped Storage Power Station (PETS), commissioned in 2004. It consists of a hydraulic system composed of two 1.3 million-m 3 water reservoirs connected by a pipeline with two hydroelectric production units between the basins.

Anticipating the projected decrease in precipitation, Morocco has expanded the capacity of its pumped storage hydropower plants, which are less dependent on precipitation than other types.
