

Oil heating steam energy storage

Indirect water heaters are a more efficient choice for most homes, even though they require a storage tank. An indirect water heater uses the main furnace or boiler to heat a fluid that's circulated through a heat exchanger in the storage tank. The energy stored by the water tank allows the furnace to turn off and on less often, which saves energy.

Sensible heat thermal energy storage materials store heat energy in their specific heat capacity (C_p). The thermal energy stored by sensible heat can be expressed as $Q = m \cdot C_p \cdot \Delta T$ where m is the mass (kg), C_p is the specific heat capacity ($\text{kJ} \cdot \text{kg}^{-1} \cdot \text{K}^{-1}$) and ΔT is the raise in temperature during charging process. Types of heating. There are two basic types of heating: direct and indirect. As the name implies, direct heating means the product contained in the tank is in direct contact with the heat source; while indirect heating involves an intermediate fluid that transports energy from the point where it is produced (the heater) to the tank, where it is then transferred to the product stored in the tank.
