

Fluid Hydraulic Accumulator. A hydraulic accumulator is a pressure storage reservoir in which a non-compressible hydraulic fluid is held under pressure by an external source. The external source can be a spring, a raised weight, or a compressed gas. An accumulator enables a hydraulic system to cope with extremes of demand using a less powerful ...

Open the valve on the bottle first, now using the hand valve on the charging hose open it to allow nitrogen to flow into accumulator. Accumulators should never be charged to more then 65% (2/3) the pump operating pressure. For example if your system is operating at 900 psi the accumulator would be charged to 600 psi this is 65% or 2/3

A hydraulic accumulator is used for one of two purposes: either to add volume to the system at a very fast rate or to absorb shock. Which function it will perform depends upon its pre-charge. If the accumulator is to be used to add volume to the system, its pre-charge must be somewhat below the maximum system pressure so oil can enter it.

Float accumulators allow a buoyant valve to open and close the accumulator when necessary. For seamless high pressure bladder accumulators, chrome-moly steel has been used extensively for more than 40 years. This material has a high tensile strength, equivalent to AISI 4130.
