Thermal energy storage based on phase change materials (PCMs) can improve the efficiency of energy utilization by eliminating the mismatch between energy supply and demand. It has become a hot research topic in recent years, especially for cold thermal energy storage (CTES), such as free cooling of buildings, food transportation, electronic cooling, ...

Phase-change materials (PCM) have been developed as promising energy storage materials to address the problems of energy supply and demand [[12], [13], [14]]. Polyethylene glycol (PEG), a PCM, has attracted considerable interest due to its high latent heat of phase change, environment friendliness, low cost, and recyclability.

In addition, the fin-enhanced structure and active phase change slurry (PCS) can effectively improve the reliability and flexibility of BTMS applications. The hybrid BTMS consisting of PCM and other cooling technology can promote the heat dissipation of PCM, which helps to solve PCM heat saturation and further reduce the battery temperature.

Phase change materials (PCMs) are gaining increasing attention and becoming popular in the thermal energy storage field. Microcapsules enhance thermal and mechanical performance of PCMs used in thermal energy storage by increasing the heat transfer area and preventing the leakage of melting materials.

A lot of researches on phase change materials have been conducted. Bejan et al. experimentally investigate the charge and discharge processes for an organic PCM (RT35 paraffin) macroencapsulated in an aluminium rectangular cavity.

The use of composite phase change materials effectively addresses LIB thermal management widely used in electric vehicles while mitigating thermal runaway, besides providing flame retardancy, thermal/mechanical stability, and electrical insulation, and preventing leakage.

The value of a phase change material is defined by its energy and power density--the total available storage capacity and the speed at which it can be accessed. These are influenced by material properties but cannot be

defined with these properties alone.

The heat absorbed and released during the phase transition is much larger than the sensible thermal energy storage. Generally, when a phase change material transforms from one phase state to another, a large amount of heat is absorbed or released in the environment. During phase change, the temperature remains basically constant.

Thermal energy storage technology can improve thermal energy utilization efficiency, and it plays a key role in the development of renewable energy [7].
