

Factors Affecting the Return of Energy Storage Systems. Several key factors influence the ROI of a BESS. The energy storage capacity, E , is calculated using the efficiency calculated above to represent energy losses in the BESS itself. This is an approximation since actual battery efficiency will depend on operating parameters such as charge/discharge rate (Amps) and temperature.

For example, if our total daily average energy demand is 15,000 Wh, we work backward to find that we need a battery capacity of 10,000 Wh ($10,000 \times 1.5 = 15,000$). To find our hours of autonomy, we multiply our newly found battery capacity (10,000 Wh) by 24 hours, then divide that by the daily average energy demand (15,000 Wh).
