



# Poland new energy storage power station

Government officials said the nuclear plant would feature six AP1000 pressurized water reactors, with total generation capacity of 6 GW to 9 GW. The country's energy plan calls for construction ...

GE Renewable Energy said Thursday it has been contracted to replace the four 125-MW pumped turbines and generators of the 500-MW Porabka Zar, the second largest pumped hydro storage power plant in Poland. The customer is PGE Odnawialna SA, a subsidiary of PGE Polska Grupa Energetyczna SA (WSE:PGE).

GE Renewable Energy has been awarded a contract by Poland's PGE Odnawialna S.A. to upgrade the Porabka Zar pumped storage hydropower plant. The project involves the replacement of four 125MW pumped turbines and generators in a bid to extend the hydropower plant's lifespan and increase its efficiency.

Poland plans to earmark 4.6 billion zloty (\$1.2 billion) in the 2025 budget to begin preparations for building the nation's first nuclear power plant. Poland needs both renewable energy and nuclear generation to reduce cost of electricity, Finance Minister Andrzej Domanski said in Olsztyn, northeast Poland.

The project, expected to be tendered in mid-2024, aims to support the balancing of PGE's land and offshore wind farms on the Baltic Sea. Funded by the National Recovery Plan, the storage facility will enhance the stability of the National Power System during the energy transition and provide a stable revenue source for PGE.

The new investment will strengthen Poland's energy security and ensure stable energy supplies for approx. 2 million households and new jobs both during construction and subsequent operation. "Due to the huge challenges in the transformation of the energy sector, investments based on the latest technologies are necessary.

The storage system will be set up at the 716-MW Żarnowiec pumped-storage power plant with 3,600 MWh of storage capacity.
