Batteries Part 1 - As Energy Storage Devices. Batteries are energy storage devices which supply an electric current. Electrical and electronic circuits only work because an electrical current flows around them, and as we have seen previously, an electrical current is the flow of electric charges (Q) around a closed circuit in the form of negatively charged free electrons.

A power bank of any kind can be defined as a portable storage device that can supply power from its built-in USB port. Now, a solar power bank isn't much different than that, the primary differentiation that must be made is a solar storage unit produces its energy from the sunlight it collects.

Storage capacity tells you how much charge the power bank can hold for later use, when you're ready to recharge your devices. Capacity is measured in milliamp hours (mAh), Amp hours (Ah) or watt hours (Wh). (Anything with a capacity about 100,000mAh will often switch to using "watt hours".)

Some power banks attach directly to smartphones via magnetic connection. These power banks are compact units that typically pack just enough power to recharge a compatible smartphone a single time.
