



Power capacity ratio of energy storage

Determine energy (MWh): Based on the above needs for total power capacity, perform a state of charge (SOC) analysis to determine the needed duration of the energy storage system (typically 30 minutes to 2 hours).

Energy capacity. Measured in megawatthours (MWh), this is the total amount of energy that can be stored or discharged by the battery. A battery's duration is the ratio of its energy capacity to its power capacity. For instance, a battery with a 2 MWh energy capacity and 1 MW power capacity can produce at its maximum power capacity for 2 hours.

We calculate a battery's duration by using the ratio of energy capacity (measured in megawatthours [MWh]) to power capacity (in MW). Energy capacity refers to the total amount of energy these batteries can store. The energy-to-power ratio (EPR) of battery storage affects its utilization and effectiveness. Higher EPRs bring larger economic, environmental and reliability benefits to power system. Higher EPRs are favored as renewable energy penetration increases. Lifetimes of storage increase from 10 to 20 years as EPR increases from 1 to 10.

Rated power capacity is the total possible instantaneous discharge capability (in kilowatts [kW] or megawatts [MW]) of the BESS, or the maximum rate of discharge that the BESS can achieve, starting from a fully charged state. Storage duration is the amount of time storage can discharge at its power capacity before

depleting its energy capacity.
