Energy density is the amount of energy that can be stored in a given system, substance, or region of space. Energy density can be measured in energy per volume or per mass. The higher the energy density of a system or material, the greater the amount of energy it has stored. A material can release energy in four types of reactions.

The higher the energy density of the fuel, the more energy may be stored or transported for the same amount of volume. The energy of a fuel per unit mass is called its specific energy. Power density (specific power) is defined as the ratio of available power from an energy storage cell to its weight or volume, which is typically expressed as gravimetric power density (usually W kg -1) and volumetric power density (usually W L -1). Both energy density and power density are the most important evaluation indices for a cell ...

This metric, typically denoted in watts per cubic meter (W/m 3), serves as a fundamental measure for evaluating the efficacy and capability of various devices, systems, and materials based on their spatial energy distribution. The concept of power density finds extensive application in physics, engineering, electronics, and energy technologies.

Power density is a measure of the power output per unit volume or mass of an energy storage device, reflecting how quickly energy can be delivered to a load. This concept is crucial for understanding the performance of various energy storage technologies, especially in applications where rapid energy discharge is required.

If a system has a high energy density then it is able to store a lot of energy in a small amount of mass. A high energy density does not necessarily mean a high power density. An object with a high energy density, but low power density can perform work for a relatively long period of time.

It is more useful for an energy storage device to have a high energy density. This means the device will be able to supply energy over a longer period of time, which is optimal for portable electronics or vehicles. However, if a storage device has a large energy density, then the power density is usually compromised.

Materials exhibiting high energy/power density are currently needed to meet the growing demand of portable electronics, electric vehicles and large-scale energy storage devices. The highest energy densities are achieved for fuel cells, batteries, and supercapacitors, but conventional dielectric capacitors are receiving increased attention for pulsed power ...
