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Concentrating solar power plants use sensible thermal energy storage, a mature technology based on molten salts, due to the high storage efficiency (up to 99%). Both parabolic trough collectors and the central receiver system for concentrating solar power technologies use molten salts tanks, either in direct storage systems or in indirect ones. But ...

The report advocates for federal requirements for demonstration projects that share information with other U.S. entities. The report says many existing power plants that are being shut down can be converted to useful energy storage facilities by replacing their fossil fuel boilers with thermal storage and new steam generators.

In December 2022, the Australian Renewable Energy Agency (ARENA) announced funding support for a total of 2 GW/4.2 GWh of grid-scale storage capacity, equipped with grid-forming inverters to provide essential system services that are currently supplied by thermal power plants.

When the giant Fengning plant near Beijing switches on its final two turbines this year, it will become the world's largest, both in terms of power, with 12 turbines that can generate 3600 megawatts, and energy storage, with nearly 40,000 megawatt-hours in its upper reservoir.

The research involves the review, scoping, and preliminary assessment of energy storage technologies that could complement the operational characteristics and parameters to improve fossil thermal plant economics, reduce cycling, and minimize overall system costs.

Herzog says it is possible to envision the technology capturing even 98 or 99 percent of a power plant's CO<sub>2</sub>. To realize that goal, however, power plants will have to pay a lot more for every extra molecule of CO<sub>2</sub> they capture--which means they need stronger financial incentives to cut their carbon emissions.

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
