This movement features about 38 hours of power reserve and vibrates at 28,800 beats per hour. It comes at 25.6mm in diameter and a fair 4.6mm in thickness. Moreover, the movement is now known as ETA 2824-2, the "-2" suffix refers to its generation. Watches that feature this calibre include the Tissot Carson via the Powermatic 80 movement.

The Caliber is an automatic mechanical movement and was introduced in 1999. The movement has a free-sprung balance and operates within COSC of -4 to +6 seconds per day. Flashback to 2020, before the pandemic started. I serviced Omega 8500 and this is one of the best timegrapher results I had so far after working on many Omega 8500 caliber since 2008 or 2009. After a few upgrades to eliminate some issues and flaws. It's one of the most accurate watches I have ever come across so far.

Owners of a caliber 8500 pre-2011 can have the balance springs easily upgraded. The movement is powered by two mainspring barrels which are coated with DLC (Diamond-like-Carbon). The DLC coating helps reduce friction and thus extends the life of the mainspring barrels.



The other component made of silicon is the balance wheel, further increasing the movement's resistance to the influence of magnetic fields. (Correction: The calibre 8500 is not equipped with silicium hairspring and balance wheel.) Other notable features of the caliber 8500 include: Dual mainspring barrels to increase the power reserve to 60 ...

MOVEMENT I am not a watchmaker, so my opinion here is just an educated user's perspective. The Omega Seamaster Aqua Terra has the by now, tried-and-tested 8500 movement. It boasts a significantly longer power reserve (see table above), which means that if you put the watch down on Friday evening, it will still be ticking come Monday morning.



The new caliber 8500 found in the Aqua Terra also feature a hairspring made of Si 14, which is non-magnetic, more shock resistant and has improved isochronism.
