Construction of an electrochemical energy storage. As can be seen, typically electrochemical energy stores consist of two electrodes (anode, cathode). The anode is an electrode, where oxidation typically occurs, while the cathode is an electrode, where reduction occurs.

Superconducting magnetic energy storage (SMES) systems store energy in a magnetic field created by the flow of direct current in a superconducting coil that has been cooled to a temperature below its superconducting critical temperature. A typical SMES system includes a superconducting coil, power conditioning system and refrigerator.

The electrochemical energy storage/conversion devices mainly include three categories: batteries, fuel cells and supercapacitors.
