

# Principle of energy storage air-cooled battery

Thermal energy can generally be stored in two ways: sensible heat storage and latent heat storage. It is also possible to store thermal energy in a combination of sensible and latent, which is called hybrid thermal energy storage. Figure 2.8 shows the branch of thermal energy storage methods.

One such advancement is the liquid-cooled energy storage battery system, which offers a range of technical benefits compared to traditional air-cooled systems. Much like the transition from air cooled engines to liquid cooled in the 1980's, battery energy storage systems are now moving towards this same technological heat management add-on.

Secondly, the heating principle of the power battery, the structure and working principle of the new energy vehicle battery, and the related thermal management scheme are discussed.

a. Principle. Air cooling of lithium-ion batteries is achieved by two main methods: Natural Convection Cooling: This method utilises natural air flow for heat dissipation purposes. It is a passive system where ambient air circulates around the battery pack, absorbing and carrying away the heat generated by the battery.

Considering the calculation accuracy and time consumption, the air-cooled system of the energy storage battery container is divided into 1000,000 meshes in this paper, which is feasible for the later calculations. At this time, the grid quality is 0.8.

The basic principle of the air-cooled is to use a fan to blow air to the face of the cell, achieving the outward transfer of battery heat. Although the system has the merit of structure simply and low-cost, the air cooling efficiency is relatively limited when the cooling demand is high, making it difficult to meet the heat dissipation needs of ...

The parallel air-cooled system is commonly applied in electric vehicles to cool the battery pack, in which flow pattern significantly influences the system cooling performance. In this paper, the curved divergence and convergence plenums are used to design the flow pattern in the parallel air-cooled system for battery thermal management.

Karimi et al. [131] analyzed and assessed the effects of water, silicone oil, and air as cooling media on battery temperature. In contrast to air cooling, water, and silicone oil cooling keep the temperature of the battery within the reasonable operating range, as shown in Fig. 4 a. However, there still exists a certain  $T_v$  inside the

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batteries.

The heat from solar energy can be stored by sensible energy storage materials (i.e., thermal oil) [87] and thermochemical energy storage materials (i.e.,  $\text{CO}_3\text{O}_4/\text{CoO}$ ) [88] for heating the inlet air of turbines during the discharging cycle of LAES, while the heat from solar energy was directly utilized for heating air in the work of [89].

Energy storage liquid cooling technology is a cooling technology for battery energy storage systems that uses liquid as a medium. Compared with traditional air cooling methods, energy storage liquid cooling technology has better heat dissipation effect and can effectively improve the working efficiency and lifespan of battery systems.

Fig. 4 shows the schematic diagram of the air cooling of the energy storage battery thermal management system. The containerized storage battery compartment is separated by a bulkhead to form two small battery compartments with a completely symmetrical arrangement. The air-cooling principle inside the two battery compartments is exactly the same.

Large energy storage systems often need to handle large amounts of heat, especially during high power output and charge/discharge cycles. Liquid cooling systems can control the battery temperature well. They prevent overheating and ensure the system runs stably for a long time. They also improve the life and safety of the

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energy storage system.

However, as the energy density of battery packs increases, the cooling efficiency of air cooling is insufficient to meet the heat dissipation requirements [11]. PCM utilizes the physical property of phase change, absorbing and releasing heat during the solid-liquid phase transition, which expands the limitations of active heating/cooling [13] .

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
