Pumped Hydroelectric Storage (PHS) PHS systems pump water from a low to high reservoir, and release it through a turbine using gravity to convert potential energy to electricity when needed 17,18, with long lifetimes (50-60 years) 17 and operational efficiencies of 70-85% 18.; PHS provides more than 90% of EES capacity in the world 19, and 96% in the U.S 20.

For energy storage technologies to be connected to the electric grid, integration technologies are often required. These integration technologies may include power electronic systems, conversion, electric motors, and protection and isolation systems.

Phase change material-based cold energy storage is a new technology that has been vigorously promoted as an energy saving measure [1, 2]. When cold energy storage materials undergo a state change, the latent heat, sensible heat, and chemical reaction heat are stored in high density, which allows efficient control of the ambient temperature.

Another demonstration project of full-process CO 2 capture and deep saline aquifer storage, operated by CHN ENERGY, began construction in 2019 and is currently in progress. It will be utilized for CO 2 storage in saline aquifers after completion with an estimated annual CO 2 storage capacity of 15 × 10 4 tonnes [174].
