Compressed air energy storage (CAES) plants are largely equivalent to pumped-hydro power plants in terms of their applications. But, instead of pumping water from a lower to an upper pond during periods of excess power, in a CAES plant, ambient air or another gas is compressed and stored under pressure in an underground cavern or container.

Most existing pumped hydro storage is river-based in conjunction with hydroelectric generation. Water can be pumped from a lower to an upper reservoir during times of low demand and the stored ...

Depending on storage path, its levelized electricity costs are greater than the costs for pumped hydro and compressed air storage by a factor of 2-6. A critical factor for the poor performance of hydrogen stores is their very high specific power-dependent CAPEX in combination with their short service lives and low overall efficiencies.

The improvement of compression/expansion efficiency during operation processes is the first challenge faced by the compressed air energy storage system. Therefore, a novel pumped-hydro based compressed air energy storage system characterized by the advantages of high energy storage density and utilization efficiency is proposed in this study.

This new technology is known as pumped-hydro-compressed air (PHCA) storage system [36]. Using this ESS, the limitations of both PH and CAES technologies can be overcome. In addition, technology can be less costly due to its simpler structure [37]. A review of the literature indicates that PHCA technology is in the early stages of study.

While compressed air storage systems and pumped hydro storage systems transfer electrical energy into potential energy back and forth, flywheels store energy in kinetic energy by means of rotating masses. A rotating body is accelerated to angular movement and the amount of energy stored is proportional to the angular velocity  $\omega$  (Figure 7.7).

The idea for pumped hydro storage is that we can pump a mass of water up into a reservoir (shelf), and later retrieve this energy at will--barring evaporative loss. Pumps and turbines (often implemented as the same physical unit, actually) can be something like 90% efficient, so the round-trip storage comes at only modest cost.

Chen. et al. designed and analysed a pumped hydro compressed air energy storage system (PH-CAES) and determined that the PH-CAES was capable of operating under near-isothermal conditions, with the polytropic exponent of air = 1.07 and 1.03 for power generation and energy storage, respectively, and a roundtrip efficiency of 51%.
