

Pumped hydro energy storage standards

The National Hydropower Association (NHA) released the 2024 Pumped Storage Report, which details both the promise and the challenges facing the U.S. pumped storage hydropower industry. As the global community accelerates its transition toward renewable energy, the importance of reliable energy storage becomes increasingly evident.

A pumped hydro energy storage (PHES) site requires two water bodies at different altitudes. The larger the difference in altitude, or head, the better, as the cost per unit of energy and power falls with increased head. Heads greater than 500m are preferred. On sunny and windy days water is pumped uphill to the upper reservoir.

On paper, Centennial Pumped Hydro Energy Storage is projected to add 600 MW of power to NEM. This will bridge the gap for energy storage needs and reduce the burden of cost with a half-done site.
