Pumped hydro storage is an amended concept to conventional hydropower as it cannot only extract, but also store energy. This is achieved by converting electrical to potential energy and vice versa in the form of pumping and releasing water between a lower and a higher reservoir.

Even though PSH is the most cost-effective form of grid energy storage currently available, new pumped storage development faces several challenges, such as its licensing and the valuation of the services it can provide. Accordingly, there has been very little new pumped storage development in the United States over the past 30 years.

To address the problem of unstable large-scale supply of China''s renewable energy, the proposal and accelerated growth of new power systems has promoted the construction and development of pumped storage power plants (PSPPs), and the site selection of conventional PSPPs poses a challenge that needs to be addressed urgently.

Pumped storage hydropower projects use electricity to store potential energy by moving water between an upper and lower reservoir. Using electricity from the grid to pump water from a lower elevation, PSH creates potential energy in the form of water stored at an upper elevation, which is why it is often referred to as a "water battery".
