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Okinawa Pumped Storage Plant is currently the only operational saltwater pumped storage plant in the world. The plant has an energy capacity of 30 MW with an elevation of around 154 meters and an effective head of 136 meters (the difference of 18 m is a way to describe the inefficiencies in the system). The Rocky Mountain Pumped Storage project in Rome, Georgia is the last utility grade pumped storage project constructed in the US. Completed in 1996, and generating 848MW of hydroelectric power from three reversible pump/turbine-motor/generator units, an upgrade is currently underway to increase generating capacity to approximately 1050MW.
