The energy storage control system of an electric vehicle has to be able to handle high peak power during acceleration and deceleration if it is to effectively manage power and energy flow. There are typically two main approaches used for regulating power and energy management (PEM) [ 104 ].

As an interesting ionic charge carrier, proton has the smallest ionic radius and the lowest ionic mass (Fig. 1a).
