Mongird et al. have done a cost comparison analysis for the different storage technologies over a 10-hour duration of their usable life where it was concluded that compressed-air energy storage, pumped hydro storage and hydrogen energy storage are the most cost-effective technologies [19]. Energy storage: hydrogen can act as a form of energy storage. It can be produced (via electrolysis) when there is a surplus of electricity, such as during periods of high wind or solar generation.
