

Reservoir gravity energy storage project

An old and simple application is the pendulum clock driven by a weight, which at 1 kg and 1 m travel can store nearly 10 Newton-meter [Nm], Joule [J] or Watt-second [Ws], thus 1/3600 of a Watt-hour [Wh], while a typical Lithium-ion battery 18650 cell [2] can hold about 7 Wh, thus 2500 times more at 1/20 of the weight.

The world is shifting fast towards a clean energy-powered transition. With African countries endorsing the Paris Agreement and more finance being made available for variable energy projects, such as solar and wind, it is expected that the demand for battery energy storage will rise to help meet energy demand.

The company recently commissioned a 25 MW/100 MWh gravity-based energy storage tower in China. This tower, the world's first that does not rely on pumped hydro technology, uses electric motors to lift and lower large blocks, harnessing gravity's force to dispatch electricity as needed.

Pumped hydro storage is a commercially proven, utility-scale energy storage and grid-stabilization technology. Pumped storage projects can be thought of as a large battery that uses water and gravity to store energy and generate power by moving water between reservoirs at different elevations (i.e. an upper and lower reservoir).

Another gravity-based energy storage scheme does use water--but stands pumped storage on its head. Quidnet Energy has adapted oil and gas drilling techniques to create "modular geomechanical storage."
