

Electrochemical storage (batteries) will be the leading energy storage solution in MENA in the short to medium terms, led by sodium-sulfur (NaS) and lithium-ion (Li-Ion) batteries.

September 2024 - LiNa Energy announces collaboration with ACWA Power to advance long-duration energy storage across the Middle East. Since signing a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) in February 2024, LiNa Energy has successfully completed testing of its cutting-edge sodium battery energy storage technology.

Located in Abu Dhabi, the Al Reyadah facility is the first commercial-scale carbon capture, utilization, and storage project in the Middle East. Operated by ADNOC (Abu Dhabi National Oil Company) and Masdar, this facility captures up to 800,000 tonnes of CO2 annually from Emirates Steel"s factories.

Pumped hydro storage (PHS) has the largest share of installed capacity in MENA at 55%, as compared to a global share of 90%. Pumped hydro storage is one of the oldest energy storage technologies, which explains its dominance in the global ESS market.

Advances in energy storage technology will lead to a huge transformation of the Middle East and Africa's energy market in the next decade. Battery technology has the potential to give countries their own self-sufficient, 24-hour electricity generation systems.

In Africa, the development of renewable energy has been limited, though South Africa has active auctions for energy storage projects. Earlier this week, Recurrent Energy, an Austin, Texas-based developer specialising in utility-scale solar and energy storage projects secured a multi-currency revolving credit facility valued at up to



\$1.41 billion.

The Middle East currently accounts for approximately 10% of the global CO 2 capture capacity across three large-scale commercial CCS facilities: Uthmaniyah CO 2-enhanced oil recovery (EOR) Demonstration Project in Saudi Arabia, Al Reyadah CO 2-EOR Project in Abu Dhabi and, Ras Laffan CCS Project in Qatar.

With the global solar energy and battery storage market size projected to reach \$26.08 billion by 2030, growing at a CAGR of 16.15 percent from 2022 to 2030, batteries are a new and promising market, and the Middle East can leverage this opportunity to become a pioneer in the battery energy storage system market.

An energy storage system is charged from the grid or by on-site generation to be used at a later time to take advantage of price differentials. Energy storage is used instead of upgrading the transmission network infrastructure. The storage system provides the grid with the necessary output to ensure the voltage level on the network remains steady.

The current utility business model limits the prospects of energy storage expansion opportunities, unless driven by direct governmental support. Auctions in MENA have been a major driver for renewable energy deployment, most notably for solar and wind, but only a few have included energy storage.

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
