Such accumulators are known as maintenance free, which are precharged with gas at the factory and do not require subsequent re-charging. The bellows form a hermetic seal, pre-venting the interchange of the charge gas and the (hydraulic) fluid, resulting in a leak-free assembly over the life of the system.

As system pressure exceeds gas precharge hydraulic pressure fluid flows into the accumulator. Stage D System pressure peaks. The accumulator is filled with fluid to its design capacity.

The typical design life for a hydraulic accumulator is 12 years. In many jurisdictions, periodic inspection and recertification is required. This particularly applies to hydraulic accumulators which have relatively large volumes and operate at high working pressures.
